ברוך ד' לעולם, אמן ואמן -66

We are grateful to Hashem for each kindness we get and believe with unshakeable faith that the whole world will recognize Him forever.

ויברך דוד -67

David declared young Shlomo be King ,dedicated his wealth to build the Temple to glorify the name of Hashem the Creator and Ruler of the world.

אתה הוא ה' לברך -68

Nechemia came from Shushan to help Ezra encouraging the Jews, to rid themselves of their non-Jewish wives; sincerely repent and rebuild the Bais Hamikdash. Nehemiah 9:6-11

ישיר -69

Hashem destroyed the Egyptians to eternally impress His greatness upon the whole world.

ישתבח -70

Imagine yourself walking up the 15 steps leading up to the Sanctuary, singing that the Creator is the driving force of the entire universe.

ויצר אור -71

This is the longest bracha in davening. The perfection of the rising and setting of the sun encourages us to start our lives over afresh as if we were just born.

אהבה רבה -72

Learning Torah and doing mitzvot with true faith and effort causes Hashem in His great love, to give one the ability to succeed.

שמע ישראל -73

Our whole life must be totally involved with learning Hashem's ways and knowing that all success and misfortune come from Him.

ברוך שם כבוד מלכותו לעולם ועד -74

A person must dedicate himself completely to the service of Hashem by totally giving up his sense of self, all he owns and if necessary his life.

ואהבת -75

My love for Hashem is overflowing . He created me for the purpose of earning life in the next world so I can enjoy happiness and peace forever.

ודעה אם שמע -76

If you listen well and accept the mitzvot you will succeed in acquiring the perfection needed to be worthy of receiving the true reward in the World to Come.

They Shall Make For Themselves Tzitzis -77

Tzitzis were given as a uniform of distinction reminding us to be honest, not become angry, not to stray after our eyes and honor Hashem in the way we behave.

אני ד' אלהיכם אמת -78

Hashem saved us from slavery and death. He purified us with 40 years in the desert and He gives us life, health and happiness so we may know and serve Him.

ויציב אמת -79

We give over [entrust] our worn out souls every night and with great Chesed HaShem returns it refreshed despite any sins that one may have done.

לעד ולעולמי עולמים -80

We kiss the tzitzit and release them showing our acceptance of the Torah in our lifetime believing its words will last forever!
